\$5 – MUAC Measure



The mid-upper arm circumference (MUAC) measure is a lifesaving tool in the fight against malnutrition. Wrapped around the middle part of the child's upper arm, the bracelet is a quick way to identify whether they are at risk from malnutrition and the severity of their condition.

\$5 for 50 bracelets

\$15 – Sterile Syringes



These single-use sterile syringes are vital to our disease-prevention work, and MSF uses millions of them every year. Packed in sterile wrappers, these high-grade syringes with needles come outfitted with a blocking device to prevent leaking and to help protect against the chance of exposure to blood-borne diseases like HIV.

\$15 for 200 syringes

\$25 – Safe Delivery Kit



Packed with forceps to clamp the umbilical cord, scissors for cutting the cord, ample sterile gauze and essential sterilizing tools, this kit provides everything needed to assist in uncomplicated births that don't require surgical intervention.

\$25 for one safe delivery kit

\$50 – Life Jackets



MSF provides medical care and sends out search and rescue ships to help people at risk along dangerous maritime migration routes like the Central Mediterranean Sea. Brightly coloured and buoyant, these life jackets are given to people in unsafe boats before they transfer to MSF ships, and help save lives.

\$50 for one life jacket

\$110 – Vaccine Cooler



Vaccinations give children and populations at risk the best shot at a healthy life. Insulated and lined with ice packs to keep the vaccines at the required temperature for up to two days, these cold boxes can hold up to 1,000 doses of certain kinds of vaccinations and can be carried by a single field worker. Your support helps MSF battle diseases and fight for a healthier life for everyone.

\$225 - Dressing Kit



This kit is an essential part of our emergency response work, helping MSF staff bind wounds and ease the suffering of people who have already experienced high levels of pain and trauma. Stocked with enough supplies for 100 dressings, this kit includes tape, scissors, bandages, antiseptic, syringes and gloves, helping our doctors help people in areas where medical care is extremely limited.

\$225 for one dressing kit

\$400 - Telemedicine Kit



MSF's unique telemedicine program is based in Canada and helps bring MSF's specialized, lifesaving care to people living in remote communities with limited access to healthcare services. This kit includes a phone, charger, access to telemedicine apps and a variety of services: a secure platform for uploading images and seeking consultations from specialists in other parts of the world; access to e-training; and even a one-on-one medical consultation via video conference.

\$400 for one telemedicine kit

\$1500 – Point-of-care Ultrasound (POCUS)



Also known as a hand-held ultrasound, these portable devices provide MSF teams with a cost-effective means for detecting underlying health issues in parts of the world where medical equipment and other resources are in short supply. These devices can easily be plugged into tablets or laptops, giving medical providers a flexible tool for offering a bedside diagnosis — improving the safety and accuracy of certain medical procedures and saving lives.

\$1500 for one point-of-care ultrasound device
